ANNOUNCEMENT

The Bucharest University of Economic Studies organises a selection for the following position:

Experienced researcher - 1 position, for the project „*CauseFinder: Causality in the Era of Big Data and AI and its applications to innovation management*” - 760049/23.05.2023, grant application no. 268/29.11.2022.

Part-time 40 hours/month distributed unequally, gross hourly salary 241.50 lei, fixed period of 12 months with evaluation and possibility of extension until June 30, 2026.

A. To be eligible, candidates must meet the following general and specific conditions:

1. General conditions:

- a) has Romanian citizenship, citizenship of other member states of the European Union, of states belonging to the European Economic Area and/or foreigners as defined by art. 2 letter a) from GEO 194/12.12.2002 with subsequent amendments and additions, respectively persons who do not have Romanian citizenship, citizenship of another EU member state or citizenship of the Swiss Confederation;
- b) has the minimum age regulated by the legal provisions;
- c) has full exercise capacity;
- d) fulfills the conditions of studies and, as the case may be, seniority or other specific conditions according to the requirements of the position;
- e) has not been definitively convicted for committing a crime against humanity, against the state or against the authority, at job or linked to the job, which prevents the administration of justice, forgery or acts of corruption or a crime committed with intent, which would make it incompatible with the exercise of the function, except for the situation in which rehabilitation intervened.

2. Specific conditions:

- a) the level of studies: higher education completed with a PhD degree;
- b) minimum 8 years of experience in scientific research from the completion of doctoral studies, in one of the fields: economics, business administration, cybernetics and statistics, economic informatics, finance or similar;
- c) field of study: economics, business administration, cybernetics and statistics, economic informatics, finance or similar;
- d) other specific conditions:
 - Specific requirements:
 1. Solid knowledge of statistics and probability, graph theory, causal modeling, probabilistic reasoning in artificial intelligence, anomaly detection in data mining;
 2. Experience in data analysis, statistical and econometric modeling, using Python;

3. Good skills in developing and writing scientific papers;
 4. English language skills at an advanced level;
 5. Good organisational, communication and collaboration skills with international and multidisciplinary teams.
- Specific responsibilities:
 1. Collaboration with the project team to carry out research activities, including reports, studies and scientific articles;
 2. Supporting and guiding the research team to create algorithms, code snippets and apply statistical methods to achieve the desired results;
 3. Ensuring the quality and correctness of partial and final results;
 4. Collaboration with the project team to disseminate the partial and final results;
 5. Supporting the project team in achieving the assumed objectives.

B. The selection will consist of:

1. Evaluation of applications;

2. Interview: structured interview (in case of less than 2 applications submitted, the competition committee can decide to simplify the procedure and carry out the selection without conducting the interview stage):

- *date and time of the interview:* will be communicated simultaneously with the results of the applications evaluation;
- *place of the interview:* will be communicated simultaneously with the results of the applications evaluation.

The selection steps are eliminatory, the minimum score obtained for each step is 70 points.
